### **School Background**

Northwest Pennsylvania Collegiate Academy is an urban, college preparatory magnet school with a 100% four-year college acceptance rate. Approximately 500 eighth graders apply for about 225 freshman openings; admission requirements include a minimum grade point average of 3.0, national standardized test scores at the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile or above, and two teacher recommendations. Collegiate Academy offers 24Advanced Placement courses all taught by College Board authorized faculty. The total student body takes approximately 800 Advanced Placement tests and completes over 100 dual enrollment college courses each year. Students are required to take three AP courses, and most graduate with several more.

Newsweek's annual report of top American public high schools again ranked Northwest Pennsylvania Collegiate Academy number two in Pennsylvania and top 1% nationally. In September 2013, the U.S. Dept. of Education designated our school as one of fewer than 300 Blue Ribbon Schools in the nation and the only Pennsylvania high school in the 2013 cohort, based on many criteria including test scores and rigor, staff collaboration, and community outreach. Collegiate Academy 2015 graduates have an average SAT combined math and critical reading score of 1123 and writing score average of 545. The class of 2015 received over \$17 million in college scholarship offers.

#### **Academic Sports League**

Academic Sports League is both a class and an extracurricular activity. Students on the ASL team compete in ten subject areas focused on a theme that changes yearly, as set by the United States Academic Decathlon Program. Participating students have traveled regionally and nationally to compete in the United States Academic Decathlon, including recent travel to Honolulu, HI.

Collegiate Academy has established an impressive record at state and national USAD competitions. Since 2001, the team has won the Pennsylvania championship nine times, placed at the national competition multiple times, and won national division championships three times. The team has also competed very successfully in several virtual national competitions.

Some students who have participated in the ASL program have been offered scholarships and admission to select schools including Yale University, the University of Chicago, California Institute of Technology, Johns Hopkins University and Georgetown University.
