What you will learn

In this class, you will learn to become a stronger reader by developing your reading comprehension, vocabulary, and fluency.

How You Will Learn It

Small Group Instruction

During teacher-led small group instruction, you will participate in lessons with up to 4 other students using Code or Workshop Books to learn and practice reading skills.

Read 180 Computer App

You will have 20 minutes each class to work on completing segments in the Read 180 App. You get to choose which topics you read about, and the app automatically adjusts it to your reading level based on your performance on the Map Test.

Independent Reading

You will choose a book to read for 20 minutes each class. Then, you will write a one or two sentence response to the part you read that day. Each book also has an accompanying Graphic Organizer and Quick Write Sheet to help you understand what you read. When you finish your book, you will take a brief book quiz on the Read 180 app.

Access the Read 180 App, text books, and independent reading books by going to Schoology, clicking the windowpane icon, and selecting Ed from the drop down menu.
