

An instructional program that prepares you to apply technical knowledge and skills required to perform entry level duties in law enforcement, corrections, private security, dispatch, and emergency medical services.

Students will receive training in patrol and investigative duties, corrections, crowd control, and crime scene management. They will learn and receive certification in expandable baton, pepper spray, handcuffing, self defense, basic life support, first aid and various aspects of the National Incident Management System.

In many areas of our country, police also act as first responders to medical emergencies. This program will teach students how EMT services operate and how to gain certification as an EMT (emergency medical technician).
