

Fifth Grade Expectations

- 1. Be prepared to work and learn**
- 2. Take pride in your work**
- 3. Be considerate of other learners by working and walking quietly**

Students not meeting expectations will be given an opportunity to check their actions and improve. Below is an example of the check system:

1. You will receive a verbal reminder if you are not meeting expectations
2. If you continue, you will receive your first check.
3. Two checks will result in a lunch detention.
4. Three checks will result in a parent contact and an after school detention.
5. Four checks will result in an office referral and parent contact.

No homework or planner will result in an automatic lunch detention.

The District Discipline Policy is always the main source of rules and consequences. All serious infractions will be handled as per the Discipline Policy.

We believe that students who follow the rules deserve to be treated as responsible, mature and independent learners. Those students who consistently follow the rules will be rewarded during the year with tickets that will enable them to “purchase” many special privileges and rewards.
