

## Counting On Cube Trains



**Check Understanding**  
Find  $7 + 3$ . Tell what strategy you used.

### What You Need

- 10 connecting cubes
- Number Cards 2–3
- Recording Sheet

### What You Do

1. Take turns. Pick a number sentence on the **Recording Sheet**.
2. Make a train with that number of cubes.
3. Pick a card. Count on that number.
4. Complete the number sentence.

#### Example

Pick  $8 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$ .

Make a cube train.



Pick  $2$ . Count on.



Write  $8 + 2 = 10$ .

## Counting On Cube Trains

Partner A	Partner B
$5 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$6 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
$7 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$5 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
$4 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$6 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
$6 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$7 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
$5 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$4 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
$4 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$	$7 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$
