Joining a Classroom as a Student:

To use Google Classroom, your child will need to sign in on a computer or mobile device, and then join a class. Once your child has joined a class, they will have the ability to receive work from their teacher and communicate with their classmates that have joined the same class.

There are two ways for a student to join a class. Your teacher can provide you a class code that you can use to add yourself to the class. You teacher can also send you an invitation to join a class. When an invitation is sent, you'll see Join on the class card on your Classroom homepage.
