# 1. Erie High School

**Average overtime** to cover activities & Cleanup after games (including but not limited to: Basketball; wrestling; football; and volleyball) on Saturday / Sundays = **12** hours per weekend.

### 2. Northwest Pennsylvania Collegiate Academy

**Average overtime** time accounted for - Plays, Football and Soccer dinners, Robotics, Sophomore Lockdown, ACT/SATs, Excellence Ceremony, Recruitment Open House. These hours are not weekly, which means in the end it becomes 1.5 hours per week of overtime.

#### 3. East Middle School

**Average overtime** to cover activities & Cleanup after games (including but not limited to: basketball and dances) on Saturday / Sundays = **6** hours per weekend.

Just games and dances on the weekend as needed as no weekday after school activities require overtime.

### 4. Strong Vincent Middle School

**Average overtime** to cover activities & Cleanup after games (including but not limited to: basketball and dances) on Saturday / Sundays = 6 hours per weekend

Added: Erie Philharmonic is housed at Strong Vincent. They typically have three or four events throughout the school year. They host various concerts. They pay the district a fee. The Erie Phil consistently uses classrooms, too.

Added: Gannon and Highmark (Community Schools Partners) have two or three events each semester on Saturdays.

Added: Various community activities use our library, auditorium and cafeteria. Maintenance staff has to open and close the building as well as clean up after they leave. (Our West Bayfront, Gannon University, Erie Ballet, Footlights)

### 8. Grover Cleveland Elementary School

Grover Cleveland is a steam building which means any activity where the heat is on, the engineer has to be present (GEARS/Carpe Diem 2:30-5:30 Mon- Thur), bank time on weekends (1 hour at GC and 1 hour at Irving both Saturday and Sunday), every once in a while a PTSA movie night, Title family night, or nondistrict facility request use (auditorium for the Indian Festival)
