## ACKNOWLEDGMENT

### I.

I acknowledge that I have received a copy of the "Erie's Public Schools Student Handbook and Code of Conduct" for the 2022-2023 school year. I acknowledge that these policies have been reviewed with me and that I have had the opportunity to read, ask questions about and fully understand the policies and consequences contained therein.

### II.

I acknowledge that the use of a school locker is a privilege, not a right.

While Erie's Public Schools is willing to provide to students a locker in which to place school materials and personal property, I understand that Erie's Public Schools does not relinquish its exclusive control of these lockers.

I understand that all lockers are and shall remain the property of Erie's Public Schools.

I have reviewed and I understand the "Lockers and Locks" section contained in my school's Student Handbook. I understand that I may use a lock to keep my locker secure against intrusions from other students. However, I have agreed to give to my school administrators the combination or an extra key to the lock which I use on my school locker. **I understand that I have no expectations of privacy in my locker. I understand that my locker may be inspected or searched by a school official or employee at any time, for any reason.**

### III.

I specifically acknowledge that I have reviewed and understand the Erie's Public Schools' policies regarding "Weapons," and I understand that my parent cannot authorize me to bring a weapon to school for any reason. I have also reviewed and understand the "Terroristic Threats/Terrorist Acts" and "Assaults/Physical Acts of Violence," "Unauthorized Substances," and the policy regarding "Weapons Search with a Metal Detector," as set forth in the Student Handbook. I have also reviewed and agree to abide by the requirements of the Computer/Internet Acceptable Use Policy ("Computer Misuse").

### IV.

I also acknowledge that the following general rules are applicable to each and every student behavior offense outlined in the Student Handbook:

1. *The student behavior rules and requirements are applicable to students while on school property, at any school sponsored activity (including graduation, dances, field trips, etc.), and on any public conveyance providing transportation to a school or school sponsored activity.*
2. *The student behavior rules and requirements are applicable to students going to and returning from school and all school-sponsored activities, including athletic events held off of school property.*
3. *Depending on the severity of a student's behavior, any student behavior offense may be treated as a second or third offense.*
4. *Chronic patterns of any student behavior offense, or a combination of student behavior offenses, will result in the student being referred to the alternative education program or, if warranted, expulsion.*
5. *Any violation of student behavior offenses may be reported to appropriate law enforcement officials who may subsequent criminal charges against the student when warranted.*
6. *Students who are on "out of school suspension" or have been referred to the alternative education program or expelled may not participate in any school-sponsored events including, but not limited to, athletic programs, dances and graduation ceremonies.*
