## Goals

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- \* Focus on credit deficient junior and senior students.
- \* Create student success portfolios.
- \* Offer core content remedial opportunities.
- \* Provide flexible schedule.
- \* Extra-curricular offerings at the Boys and Girls Club.
- \* Identify educational and life goals and support those goals with career coaching and mentoring.

## Method

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- \* Students set short and long term academic and social goals.
- \* Students create an action plan.
- \* Students will partner with peers who will be their mentor to ensure the plan is being followed.
- \* Students share their goals with others and celebrate successes.
- \* Quarterly feedback/reflection with staff on their plan.
