

## 4th Quarter In-Person Learning

Dear Parent and Student,

You are scheduled to come back to Wilson School. You should wear a mask and socially distance yourself.

Enter through your assigned grade level door. Please note your grade's return date. All other students will remain remote and follow the schedule that your teacher has provided to you. Upon returning to Wilson, you will have your temperature taken and be escorted to your classroom by your teacher.

April 6<sup>th</sup>- all students will be asynchronous today. Log into your classes to view and complete your assignments.

April 7<sup>th</sup> Grade 6 returns to school -enter through the front East 28<sup>th</sup> Street doors at 8:40. (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade will continue remote instruction)

**April 8<sup>th</sup> Grade 7** returns to school - enter through the SW Reed Street doors at 8:40. (8<sup>th</sup> grade will continue remote instruction)

April 9th Grade 8 returns to school - enter through the SE Monroe Street doors at 8:40.

## **Daily Schedule:**

8:40	Enter your assigned door- you will have your temperature taken.  If you come in after this time- you must enter the front East 28 <sup>th</sup> Street doors and follow tardy procedures.
8:45-10:00	Breakfast & Period 1
10:00-11:00	Period 2
11:00-12:55	Lunch & Period 3- teacher will take you to pick up lunch @ your scheduled time.
12:55-1:55	Period 4
1:55-3:00	Period 5
3:00-3:05	Lockers & Dismissal

**NOTE:** Please bring the materials that you received at the beginning of the year in a backpack: 2 Math workbooks, 2 Language Arts workbooks, Chromebook and charger, a pencil bag with sharpened pencils and a pen and personal sanitizer if desired.
