# <u>Principal Report – Michelle Fiorelli</u>

- Currently have 614 students.
- Reminder please do not drop students off at school until 7:45AM as that is when the doors open. There are students being dropped off as early as 7:15AM waiting in the rain, cold and snow.
- Please do not pull into the bus lane to drop off students. There have been days that the buses cannot pull into the bus lane due to parents being parked forcing the bus drivers to stop on 38th street blocking traffic.
- Weather emergencies/school closings will be announced on the district website and media outlets. Parents are allowed to keep students home at their discretion if they feel the weather or conditions are too hazardous for the student to come to school. Normally a parent need just send in a note with the child stating they were not in school at parental discretion. Please see the district website for further explanation.
- No new updates on our district financial situation. Still waiting to hear back from Harrisburg about our financial recovery plan.

  - o Brian Polito our current CFO was voted in as the new Superintendent by the school board.

- There was some community pushback regarding voting in a new superintendent so quickly and doing so internally without publishing nationally for the position.
- It was discussed that promoting within has been done in the past and the decision was made not to publish the position nationally due to the need for continuity especially given the current situation with the school district and funding. If our plan is approved by the State, then we <u>must</u> follow the plan to the letter and as Brian Polito helped write the plan he is the person most knowledgeable to help follow.
- o Mr. Polito is also well connected in Harrisburg and will continue to work with transparency moving forward.
- Additionally, it would take up to a year to bring someone new up to speed on the entire situation and that is time we do not have.
- o In the end, it was a unanimous vote to appoint Brian Polito as the new superintendent
- It was also discussed that the National Immigration Law will impact our area as we are a
  "Refugee Resettlement County" which means undocumented immigrants are safe in the
  City/County.
