SCHOOL BACKGROUND

Northwest Pennsylvania Collegiate Academy is an urban, college preparatory magnet school with a 100% four-year college acceptance rate for college prep students. Approximately 500 eighth graders apply for about 225 freshman openings; admission requirements include a minimum grade point average of 3.0, national standardized test scores at the 75th percentile or above, and two teacher recommendations. Collegiate Academy offers 26 Advanced Placement courses all taught by College Board authorized faculty. The total student body takes approximately 800 Advanced Placement tests and over 100 students participate in dual enrollment college courses each year. Students in the college prep tract are required to take a minimum of three AP courses for graduation. The student population is diverse ethnically, racially, and socioeconomically. The ethnic/racial composition is 64% White/Caucasian. 17% Black/African American, 4% Asian, 8% Hispanic, 6% two or more races, .2 % other.
