





Apple Snack Sail Ships



- 1.Apples – each apple makes two boats
- 2.Your favorite spread – peanut butter, honey, sun butter or Nutella
- 3.Puffed rice or other cereal Cheese Toothpicks

To make:

1. Cut the apple in half, removing the core.

Half of a paper plate
Crayons, scissors, glue
Construction paper
