# This is *mandatory* for all <u>non-public</u> school students who are <u>currently</u> taking a full Algebra I course (not pre-algebra or algebra 1/2)

- All <u>public school</u> students who are currently taking an Algebra I course <u>should be taking the</u>
   <u>Keystone Exams in their current school</u> before the end of the year do not need to attend. IF you are unsure if your school will offer the Algebra Keystone test, PLEASE ask your current school.
- Students in public and private schools who are <u>not</u> currently taking an Algebra 1 course will be scheduled for Algebra I class in the fall and will take the Keystone at the end of 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

Students may bring calculators to use during the Algebra Keystone Test. *Cell phones are not permitted and will be collected prior to testing.* **This test is an un-timed. Students** <u>may</u> be done before or after 2:00.

Please allow for some flexibility with the timing of the exam.
