ALGEBRA KEYSTONE EXAM

8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Students should enter through the State Street Doors

This is *mandatory* for all non-public school students who are currently taking a full Algebra I course (not pre-algebra or algebra 1/2)

- All public school students who are currently taking an Algebra I course ***should be taking the Keystone Exams in their current school*** before the end of the year do not need to attend. IF you are unsure if your school will offer the Algebra Keystone test, PLEASE ask your current school.
- Students in public and private schools who are **not** currently taking an Algebra 1 course will be scheduled for Algebra I class in the fall and will take the Keystone at the end of 9th grade.

Students may bring calculators to use during the Algebra Keystone Test. *Cell phones are not permitted and will be collected prior to testing. This test is an un-timed. Students may be done before or after 2:00.*

Please allow for some flexibility with the timing of the exam.
