Frequently Asked Questions

What is the difference between the two platforms?

Credit Recovery – Limited to lack of progress or completion of 4th quarter. 100% of the course is required, which will be less than summer school.

Summer School – Student failed a course/s needed for graduation. If summer school is not successfully completed, the student may not graduate on time and, therefore, may need to enroll in the Recovery Academy. 100% of the course is required.

Is there a cost?

No, there is not a cost to the student or parent.

What do I need to begin?

A computer. If you do not have a computer, please contact the Erie Public School Instructional Technology Department at 814-874-6181.

What are the dates and times?

June 24 – July 29

Time - Students will work at their own time and pace. Therefore, you can finish early.

Where do I go to attend?

All classes for credit recovery and summer school are online. Students will use Edgenuity for most classes.

How do I log-on to begin?

How is my progress tracked and assessed?

Your teacher/s will track your progress, ex. time log on, time actively working. Once you have completed a section, your teacher/s will “open” tests as needed to progress further into the content.
