APPLICATION INSTUCTIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE, THE COMMUNITY SERVICE OR ARTS AND LETTERS SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Type or use black ballpoint pen to complete application.
- 2. Applicant must be an African American high school senior graduating in 2024 and have applied for admission in the 2023-2024 school year at a four (4) year college or university of his/her choice.
- 3. An <u>official sealed copy</u> of your high school transcript must be attached to the application with your current G.P.A.
- 4. A copy of your SAT or ACT scores must be included.
- 5. Two letters of reference are required. The letters should be included with the application in <u>sealed envelopes</u>.
- 6. Parts I through VI must be completed. Omission of any part will eliminate the application from consideration.
- 7. Part V, which is the Essay, must be completed or your application will be disqualified. The Scholarship checks are mailed to the student at the end of August once students are in school and we have received their college schedule.
- **8.** A camera-ready photograph.
