We foster and promote a safe and positive school environment that enhances student learning through teaching and acknowledging positive behavior.

## What is PBIS?

PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) is a research-based framework for teaching and supporting positive behaviors for ALL students. This school-wide approach to discipline focuses on building a positive and safe environment where all students can learn.

#### **How Does it Work?**

Students are acknowledged for being respectful, responsible, safe, and prepared. When they engage in one of the school-wide expectations, they earn an anchor. The anchors are used towards classroom-wide incentives when goals are reached.

## Who is a Magnificent Mariner?

Students who are consistently respectful, responsible, safe, and prepared will be nominated by their classroom teacher to be a Magnificent Mariner. They are honored at a breakfast with their family.

### Who is a McKinley Captain?

Students, who are in fifth grade and have been a Magnificent Mariner, can be nominated by staff, parents, and peers to be a Captain. Captains are leaders and role models for the school.
