

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we

_____ father mother and/or guardian(s) of _____

a student enrolled in the School District of the City of Erie, Pennsylvania, or the City of Erie Area Vocational-Technical School, do hereby petition the School District or School as follows:

WHEREAS, the student has an illness or disability which requires the periodic administering of medication; and

WHEREAS, the student's physician, _____ has submitted unto the School District, a written order identifying the medication and detailing the hours and units of dosage to be given to the Student, and;

WHEREAS, the parents acknowledge the administration of such medication is a gratuitous act on the part of the School District or School for which the School District or School is under no legal obligation to perform.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parents do hereby request the School District of the City of Erie, Pennsylvania or the City of Erie Area Vocational-Technical School, its agents and employees, to administer the medication herein referred to, and in order to induce the School District or School, its agents and employees, to administer such medication, do hereby remiss, release, and forever discharge the said School District of the City of Erie, Pennsylvania, or the City of Erie Area Vocational-Technical School, its members of the Board of Directors (both collectively and individually), its agents and employees, and his/her/their and its successors and assigns, heirs , executors, and administrators, of and from, any and all claims, demands, rights, and causes of action whatsoever kind and nature, arising from, and by reason of, any and all known and unknown foreseen and unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, and the consequences thereof, which hereafter may be sustained by the said minor student and by the said parents, and by any other person or persons having a legal interest therein in consequence of the administration of such medication.
