





Logging into schoolwires

<p>Once the page has loaded you can sign in by clicking the "Sign In" button found in the top right of the browser on the blue bar.</p>	
<p><u>You user name and password are the same username and password you use to access your computer.</u></p>

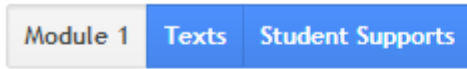
As an Erie’s Public School teacher or administrator you will be able to access additional files and resources, once signed in, which are **not** available for the general public.

You can identify which page you are currently on because it will be highlighted in **blue**. Portions of the Resources page will not be available if you are **not** signed in.
