Certified School Nurse provides a variety of services for our student which include:

- Mandated screenings including height, weight, body mass index and vision annually for all students. Information and assistance in obtaining follow-up care related to screenings
- **Hearing screenings** for students in grade 7, Special ed. Students and Learning Support Students
- **Scoliosis screenings** for students in grades 6 and 7. Parents are notified about date of screening
- Immunization review, notification and enforcement as specified by Pennsylvania requirements (see ESD cite for full list of required immunizations for all grades http://www.eriesd.org/domain/572).

Immunization requirements for ALL students entering 7th grade..

1 TdaP (Tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis) Pertussis is required.

1 Meningococcal conjugate vaccine.

(Parent/Guardian must provide a <u>current</u> copy of the student's immunization shots by May 1)

- Care for ill and injured students, including first aid, parent contact, and education regarding the student's medical treatment or care
- ALL Medication administration is provided for students only:
 - through the health room **and**
 - with a current doctor order on file

(<u>No medication</u>, including Tylenol and Ibuprofen, will be given if the student doesn't have a doctor's order for it). Students with asthma may carry Albuterol inhaler if they have a doctor's order with permission to carry it. See school nurse for forms)

- REQUIRED EXAMINATIONS:
 - **Physical examinations** are required by state law for all students in Grade 6. Must be submitted to school by October 15th **OR** your child will be scheduled for the school exam. Notification letter with school physical exam will be sent to the student's parent/guardian.
 - Dental examinations are also required by state law for all students in Grade 7.
 Must be submitted to school by October 15th OR your child will be scheduled for the school exam.
