Committee Update

Programming	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students in 11th and 12th grades will continue on course path (additional electives available); students in 10th grade begin entering magnet pathways; students in 9th grade begin to explore different electives. Schedule cards for rising for 11th and 12th grades completed; rising 10th graders to be completed by the end of week 5/29; rising 9th graders to be completed by the end of week 5/29. Assemblies were held for 8th graders at all elementary/middle schools to explain their options for next year. Discussion on the importance of clear and consistent terminology regarding the high schools. In the academies, under each magnet program are pathways (career paths): Collegiate Academy – career/college prep and Visual & Performing Arts; Erie HS – business/finance, career & tech, human services, science & health. 	
Staffing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Postings were down Friday, May 19 with one third of both high school positions filled. Mental Health and Behavior Specialists tentatively placed for next year with two additional Behavior Specialist positions posted. All athletic position posted. 	
Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two proposals for camera systems at Central were reviewed and discussed with a preference toward Video Insight. Principals, assistant principals, mental health/behavior specialists and Blue Coats prepared to be on-site for June 2 rally at the stadium. Administrators met with architects last week 	
Logistics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Letters with school location of specialized programs will be sent to families in a few weeks. Flowchart being created for moving guidelines. ServErie, who has offered a significant amount of volunteer help, has good understanding of what needs to be done in buildings and what can be started. Timeline and framework of moving being created for their support as well. July is moving month; all staff will know where they are moving by June 30.
