WHAT IS THE ACCELERATED LEARNING ACADEMY?

The EPS Accelerated Learning Academy offers a blended environment for students to recover credits and get back on track for graduation. Students attend in-person classes located at the DiPaolo Student Success Center where they utilize an online platform to complete middle school and high school courses at an accelerated pace.

- ✓ Students enrolled at the ALA have access to certified instructors both virtually and on-site, as well as other support services which are offered at their traditional home school.
- Middle School students attend classes on site from 8:00am to 2:30pm.
- High School students attend in two sessions: 8:00 am to 11:30am OR 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm
- Middle school students who live 1.5 miles or more from the Patrick J. DiPaolo Student Success Center will receive an EMTA bus pass if they require transportation.
- ✓ High school students who live 2 or more miles away will also receive a bus pass for EMTA transportation.
- Students enrolled at the Accelerated Learning Academy are considered part of their home school and, as such, receive all advantages associated with being a student in Erie's Public Schools.

GET BACK ON TRACK

Since the program began in 2017, 175 students have successfully completed 1800 courses. In our first year alone, 40 students successfully reached the requirements for graduation; with half of those students earning more than 8 credits over the course of the year. During the 2018-19 school year, the Accelerated Learning Academy helped 75 graduates earn their diplomas.
