**WHEN CAN YOU FILE YOUR FAFSA?**

## WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

- ✓ Student and parent alien registration number, if not a US citizen
- ✓ Student and parent **2021 federal income tax return and schedules**. If your taxes are not yet finalized, use the prior year's tax return and current W-2 forms to estimate your income. If you had no income, we will assist you.
- ✓ Student and Parent(s) Social Security Number and Birthdays
- ✓ Student Driver's License (optional)
- ✓ Records of other untaxed income received such as workers' compensation, child support, payments to tax-deferred pension and savings plan, etc.
- ✓ Current bank statements and records of stocks, bonds, investments, etc.
