- All **public school** students who are currently taking an Algebra I course **should take the Keystone Exams in their current school** this school year. County public school students should check with their district. **IF you are unsure if your school will offer the Algebra Keystone test, PLEASE ask your current school.**
- Students in public and private schools who are **not** currently taking an Algebra I course will be scheduled for Algebra I class in the fall and will take the Keystone at the end of 9th grade.

Students should bring calculators to use during the Algebra Keystone Test. *Cell phones are not permitted and will be collected prior to testing. This test is an un-timed test. Students **may** be done before or after 2:00 pm.*

Please allow for some flexibility with the timing of the exam.
