WHEN CAN YOU FILE YOUR FAFSA?

Students can complete their FAFSA beginning in October 2025. They will use **2024 tax information** to complete the application: www.studentaid.gov/FAFSA

Both Parent(s) & Students must come TOGETHER to complete the FAFSA

*Both students AND parent(s) will need their own StudentAid.gov Account (formerly FSA ID) username and password to complete their FAFSA. If you don't have one, go to www.studentaid.gov/fsa-id to create your Student Aid.gov account a **week before your FAFSA event.***

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

- ✓ FSA ID – both student and parent(s)
- ✓ Student and parent alien registration number, if not a US citizen
- ✓ Student and parent **2024 federal income tax return and schedules.** If your taxes are not yet finalized, use the prior year's tax return and current W-2 forms to estimate your income. If you had no income, we will assist you.
- ✓ Student and Parent(s) Social Security Number and Birthdays
- ✓ Student Driver's License (optional)
- ✓ Records of other untaxed income received such as workers' compensation, child support, payments to tax-deferred pension and savings plan, etc.
- ✓ Current bank statements and records of stocks, bonds, investments, etc.
