


## Snack Time

IF YOUR CHILD IS STAYING FOR EXTRA HELP, IT MUST BE COMMUNICATED IN ADVANCE WITH MYSELF AND A NOTE MUST BE PROVIDED ON THE DAY THAT THEY ARE STAYING. STUDENTS WILL BE GIVEN HOMEWORK THROUGHOUT THE WEEK IN OUR MATH AND LANGUAGE ARTS CURRICULUM. STUDENTS HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS WILL NOT BE GRADED, BUT IT IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED THAT THE STUDENTS COMPLETE THIS ASSIGNMENTS. STUDENTS CAN EARN CLASSROOM INCENTIVES FOR THE COMPLETION OF THEIR ASSIGNMENTS.
