



The criminal history submission form to which this notice is attached asks you to provide your criminal history. When you submit your application you are required to provide your criminal history if you have:

Section 9124© of the Criminal History Record Information Act 18 Pa C.S. Section 9124 © confers discretion upon the Department to refuse to grant a certification, recognition, or recertification, or to impose disciplinary sanctions when the applicant, or a certified or recognized prehospital practitioner, has been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor which relates to the profession.

Section 11 (j.1) (1) (xiv) of the Emergency Medical Services Act, 35 P.S. Section 6931 (j.1) (1) (xiv), confers discretion upon the Department to refuse to issue a certification, recognition or recertification, or to impose disciplinary sanctions when the applicant or a certified or recognized person, has been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude.

Title 28 § 1003.27(b), Disciplinary Action, states that it is the duty of all prehospital personnel to report to the Department, within 30 days, a misdemeanor or felony conviction, or a revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary sanction of a certificate or other authorization to practice a health care profession or occupation.

The information that you provide on the attached form must be true and complete to the best of your knowledge, information and belief. By signing the attached form, you are authorizing the Pennsylvania Department of Health to contact the law enforcement, correctional officers, present and past employers, counseling programs, and anyone specifically noted on this application and any other persons that might have information pertaining to your conviction(s).
