Action Steps and Goals

- Create a system where all teachers use collaborative time to plan and prepare intervention lessons that support all students.
- Staff will implement practices that ensure a welcoming, supported and safe school environment while sharing accountability.
- Measurable Goal: 65% of students will score at or above benchmark on DIBELS EOY assessments.
- Measurable Goal: 70% of students will pass CKLA end of unit assessments with 65% pass rate.
- Measurable Goal: 50% of students will be at or above grade level on the iReady Math EOY Diagnostic.
- Measurable Goal: 70% of students will pass iReady comprehension checks with 65% pass rate.
- Measurable Goal: 55% of EL students will be at or above benchmark on the DIBELS universal screener on the EOY.
- 55% of EL students will pass the CKLA unit assessment with a 65% pass rate.
