

An Introduction Has Three Parts

Definition	Example
Lead: The first sentence(s) is called the hook or lead. It should intrigue, invite and raise a reader's curiosity.	
Thesis Statement: The next sentence is a clear thesis or topic sentence. This sentence tells the subject or reason for writing and what will be explained to the reader.	
Overview: This sentence(s) tells the reader the supporting ideas that will clarify the topic.
