



Family Note

We are now working with "fact families". A fact family consists of 3 numbers, 2 parts and the total. Two addition and two subtraction facts can be written for each fact family of 3 numbers. For example, for the parts 3 and 4 (total 7) the addition facts are $3 + 4 = 7$ and $4 + 3 = 7$. The subtraction facts are $7 - 3 = 4$ and $7 - 4 = 3$. Dominoes are an excellent model for practicing fact families. The parts will be the numbers on each side, the total will be the total number of dots.

Write the 3 numbers for each domino. Use the numbers to write the fact family.
