

New Account Code Structure

- Reduced account numbers from 32 digits to 20
 - Updated crosswalk with lookup function is on website
 - Account lookup on procurement screen can also be used to see available accounts
- Reduced the number of expenditure accounts from 10,000+ to under 1,400
 - Eliminated small funds

All expenditures are now in the general fund
