

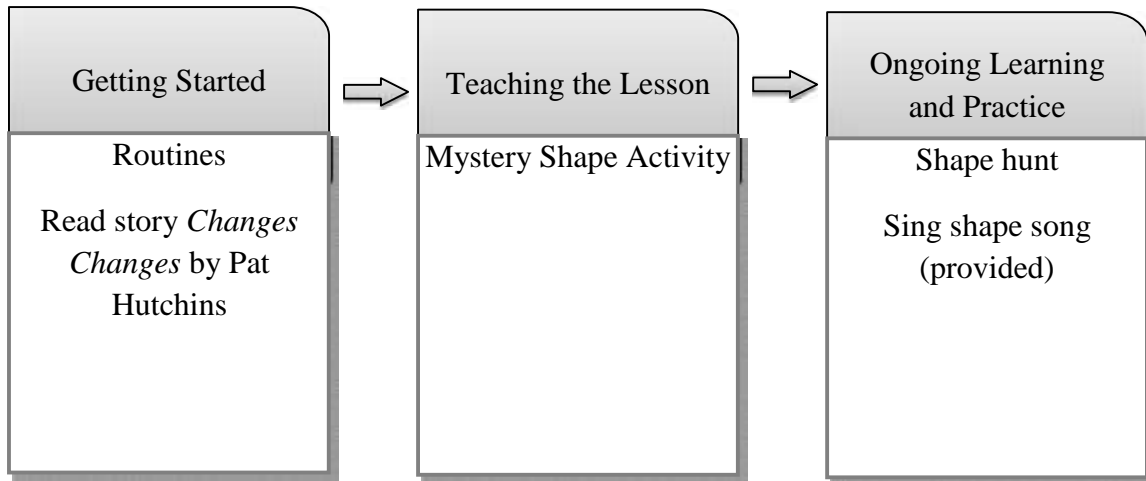
Lesson 1-1

Introduction to Shapes

Materials: 1 set of large shapes, 1 bag of shapes for each student containing; hexagon, circle, square, rectangle, and triangle (**Collect and save for next lesson**), book *Changes, Changes* by Pat Hutchins

Objective: The students will be able to identify and describe the attributes of the shapes

Standards: CC.2.3.K.A.1 (K.G.2)



Getting Started

Read the story *Changes Changes* by Pat Hutchins.

Teaching the Lesson

Mystery Shape Activity

- Teacher give each student one bag and have the students explore the contents and discuss the shapes with the other students

Show each large shape one at a time and have students find that shape from the bag provided. Then have them describe attributes and list onto the large shapes leading the students to use vocabulary such as number of sides, round, corners, curved, etc.

Shape Hunt

Have the children do a shape hunt around the room.

Shape Song:

Terry triangle, Terry triangle

Look at me, look at me.

Count my sides, count my sides.

There are three, there are three.

Sammy square, Sammy square

That's my name, that's my name.

I have four side, I have four sides
