Students are learning to solve missing addend number stories. As your child works to solve, help them to identify how many they are starting with and ending with. Then have them use strategies to solve. They may need counters.

Directions: Write an equation and solve.

Example: I have 7 books. I buy more books. Now I have 10 books. How many books did I buy?

$$7 + \underline{3} = 10$$

1. 6 kids are playing at the park. More kids come. Now there are 10 kids. How many kids came?
2. I have 7 dimes. I find more dimes. Now I have 15. How many dimes did I find?
3. There are 9 stickers on my chart. I get more stickers. Now I have 12. How many more stickers did I get?
4. There are 6 kids playing outside. More kids come to play. Now there are 11 kids playing. How many kids came?
