

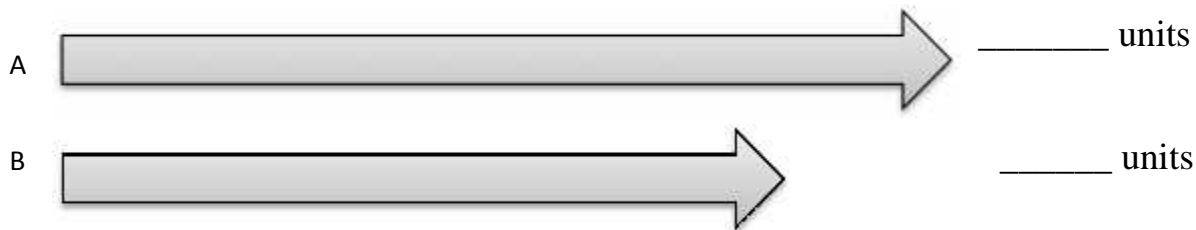
Family Note

Students have been working to compare the length of objects. We have been working to use the vocabulary of shorter than and longer than. As your child measures, reinforce placing an object end to end to measure. Since we all have different objects at home, pick something your child can use to measure. For instance, if your child uses pennies make sure they place them one against the other and record you used pennies to measure. Since we are using nonstandard measurements, any object can be used; pennies, cheerios, paperclips, etc. Just make sure they use the same object throughout as they measure.

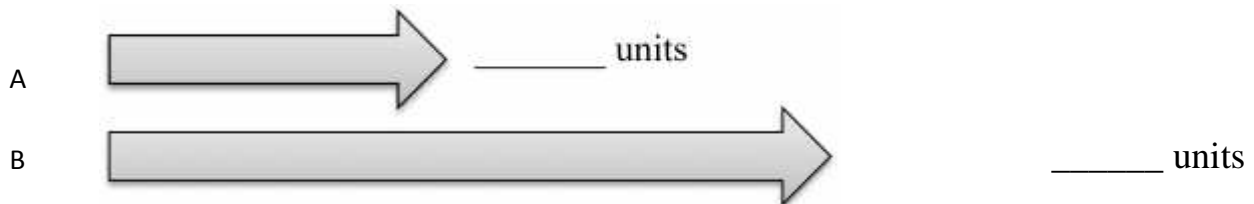
